In this wide-ranging talk, multi award-winning Perth based (and Vincent resident) writer and performer Ingle Knight will discuss the art of surviving as a freelance writer and actor in Perth, touring the world in his highly successful one-man shows, and the benefits and disadvantages of writing plays about his hometown. Ingle has won the Premier's Book Prize for his adaptation of Elizabeth Jolley's 'Milk and Honey', and is twice winner of the Equity Guild Best Play of the Year award, most recently for 'Taking Liberty', a play about the winning of the America's Cup, to be seen later this year in a new production by Deckchair Theatre.
